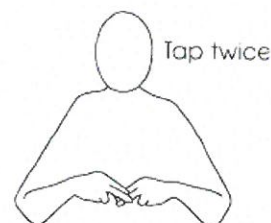
Rhyme of the week:

Daddy/ Father

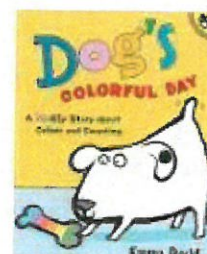


In Phonics we will be:
