





Teaching and Learning

This is the last half term for some children and we will be supporting their transition to new settings. Many staff from Primary Schools come to visit children at Hirst Wood to make the process as positive as possible. This is an exciting time for both children and parents, and we wish every child the best of luck in their new setting.

N1 and N2 - 'growing'- children will look at both fiction and non-fiction texts such as the 'The Hungry Caterpillar', 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' and 'Superworm' to extend their knowledge and understanding of growth and change. Lifecycles will be explored as children plant seeds (beans, cress and sunflowers) and observe lifecycles through their observations of tadpoles as they grow into frogs and caterpillars into butterflies.

N3 - 'transport and journeys' - a travel agents will be opened up in the role-play area which will provide lots of opportunities for imaginative play. There will be writing for a variety of purposes such as tickets, timetables and luggage labels. Children will be encouraged to look at maps and globes, and also discuss any trips that they have taken - where did they go and how did they get there? Forces will be investigated through investigation of wheeled toys - considering how we make things move.
