


Book of the week: Easter Stories

In Phonics we will be:

- We will be continuing to talk about alliteration, creating our own alliterative names for different objects.
- We will also be playing lots of fun games, identifying the initial sounds of various objects and sorting them whilst trying to beat the timer.

In Maths we will be:

- Reading the story 'We're Going on an Egg Hunt' and making marks to represent how many eggs we have found.
- We will be using positional language to talk about where we found the eggs when reading the story and when on our egg hunt outside.

Indoor and Outdoor learning:

- Reading stories about Easter and talking about why people celebrate Easter.
- Experimenting with objects, identifying which roll and which don't.
- Using cooking equipment to make chocolate Easter nests for our chicks.
- Going on an egg hunt in the Wilderness Garden.
