

In Maths we will be:

- Playing rhyming games to find words that sound the same.
- Identifying the odd one out that does not rhyme.
- Developing listening and attention through sound and word play.



Learning opportunities:


This week in our enhanced and continuous provision, the children will have opportunities to:

- Build walls, ramps, and structures using blocks, planks, and bobbins.
- Explore textures by scooping and pouring materials in the sensory tray.
- Use a range of tools in the self-serve painting area to create their own artwork.
- Act out familiar stories using small world figures and props.
- Count, share, and compare objects during snack time and play.
