As you can imagine this does impact negatively on the temperature in the rooms therefore could we ask that you dress your children in layers of additional clothing such as a thick woollen jumper and/or a fleece. ## **Applications for entry to Reception in September 2021**

The online admissions system will be available for reception applications from 9 November 2020 until 15 January 2021 for children born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017. You should receive information about making an application for reception from your child's current nursery mid-November. Please contact the Admissions Team if you do not receive this.

If your child has a formal offset agreement in place, and is therefore not born between these dates, please contact the Admissions Team for a paper application form once the application process has opened in November as you will be unable to apply through the online process.
