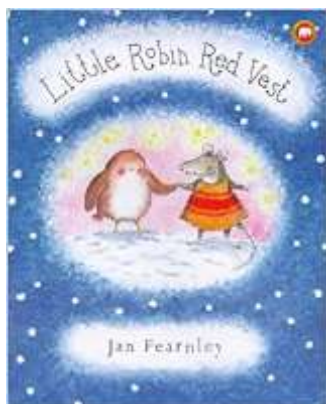

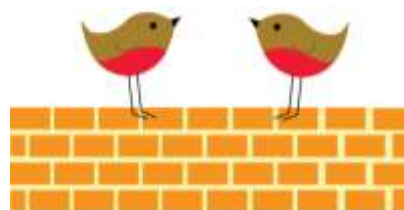

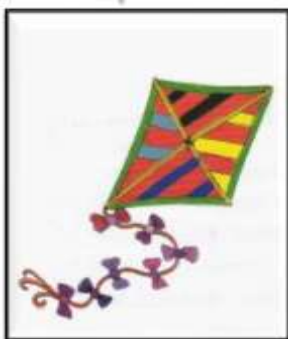


Sound of the week:
