In Maths we will be:

- Exploring shapes by naming circles, squares, triangles and rectangles, and finding objects around the classroom that match these shapes.
- Comparing big and small objects during carpet sessions and in our play areas.
- Using everyday language such as round, flat, big, small, long, short as we build, sort and explore materials together.

In Phonics we will be:

- Exploring body percussion by clapping, tapping, stamping and making simple sound patterns together.
- Playing listening and action games to help children respond to different body sounds and follow action words.
- Joining in with songs and rhymes, building rhythm and encouraging children to copy and repeat simple sound sequences.

Learning opportunities:

This week in our enhanced and continuous provision, the children will have opportunities to:

- Explore water flow and joining using plumbers' pipes in the water tray.
- Decorate the Christmas tree in the home corner, choosing their own decorations and talking about colours and placement.
- Investigate Magnatiles, bells and pipe cleaners, exploring how magnets attract and building 2D and 3D structures.
- Make long paper chains using strips of coloured paper and glue sticks to decorate the classroom.
- Explore baubles and tubes to balance, roll and build festive structures, developing problemsolving and early STEM skills.
