




In Phonics we will be: We will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listening to the first sounds in words like "tadpole," "tail," "toes"• Tapping out simple repeated rhythms.• Identifying the initial sounds of our names. 
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Learning opportunities: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Painting and printing tadpoles with our fingers• Moving like frogs and wriggling like tadpoles in a fun obstacle course• Making our own small world pond and talking about what lives there• Retelling the stories with puppets and actions• Looking at real photos of frogs, frogspawn and ponds• Singing frog rhymes like Five Little Speckled Frogs and using props to support.
