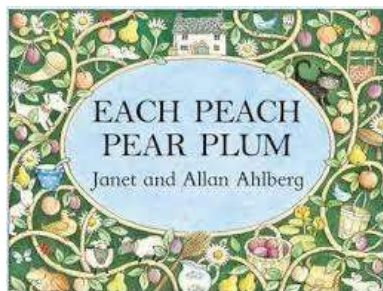

goodbye



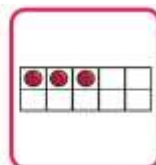
### Sound of the week:
