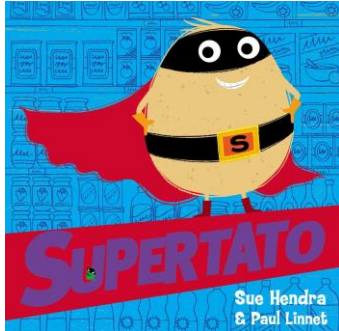

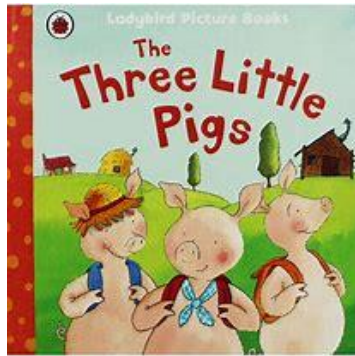
### Book of the week:

One Potato, Two Potatoes



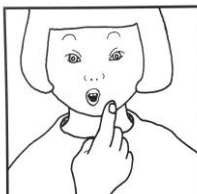
### Sounds of the week:

Pretend to be a puppy, pulling a rag, and shake your head from side to side, saying, mrrmmr.

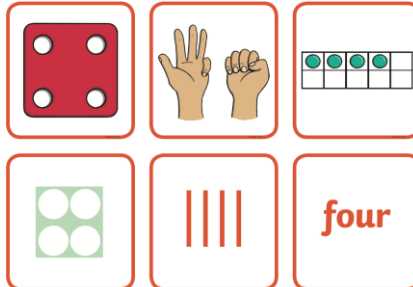


#### ACTION
