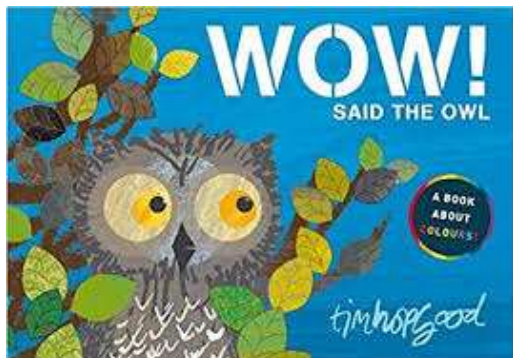

- learning about birds of prey

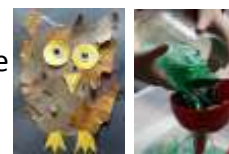
### Forest School:
