Maths

We will be:

- Recognising a small group of objects using familiar parts of our bodies like eyes, ears, and fingers together.
- Playing a game called "What's in my hand?"
 where we practise recognising small groups of
 objects by sight, helping us build early
 counting and comparison skills in a playful
 way.

Phonics

We will be:

- Using our ears to listen carefully to environmental sounds as we read What the Ladybird Heard and The Great Ah-Ooo.
- Tuning in to sounds like buzzing flies, splashing water, and rustling leaves, and having fun trying to recognise and copy them using our voices.

Learning opportunities

We will be:

- Washing in the sensory tray and having fun with bubbles.
- Looking at books and stories about cooking in the dough area.
- Practising writing and recognising our names.
- Exploring big and small objects from nature.
- Trying new ways to join things using tape, string, split pins, and fasteners.
- Painting with different tools like rollers, stamps, and natural objects.
- Solving puzzles and using our thinking skills.
- Helping to check or update the visual schedule during the day.
- Exploring spheres and cylinders to see how they roll.

Help At Home:

Curiosity Tray



Set up a simple discovery tray at home using everyday objects from nature or around the house—like leaves, shells, buttons, or pinecones. Encourage your child to explore the items using their senses: looking closely, feeling textures, and even listening to the sounds they make. Ask openended questions like "What does it feel like?" or "What do you think it's for?" to spark curiosity and conversation.
