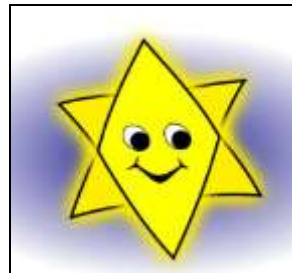
Book of the week:

Twinkle Little Star

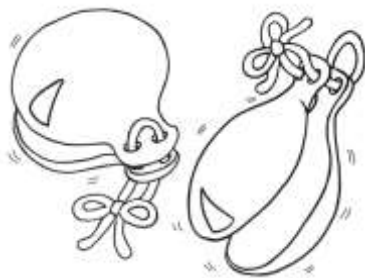


Sound of the week:

Half the class will go on the walk on each date whilst the other half stay in school.



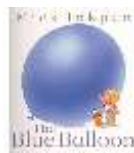
Outdoors:
