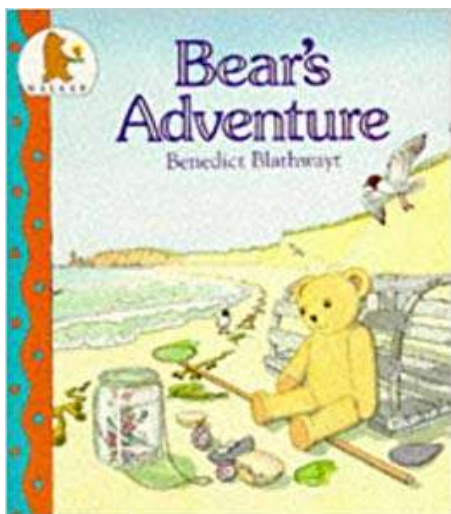

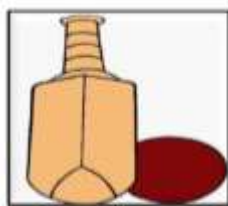


Sounds of the week:

say b.b.b.

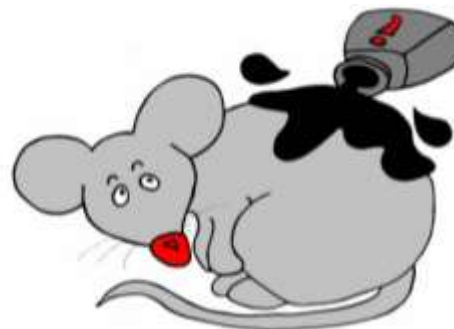


Bring your bat and bring your ball.

- making controlled marks to create our own sea scenes inspired from artist's prints



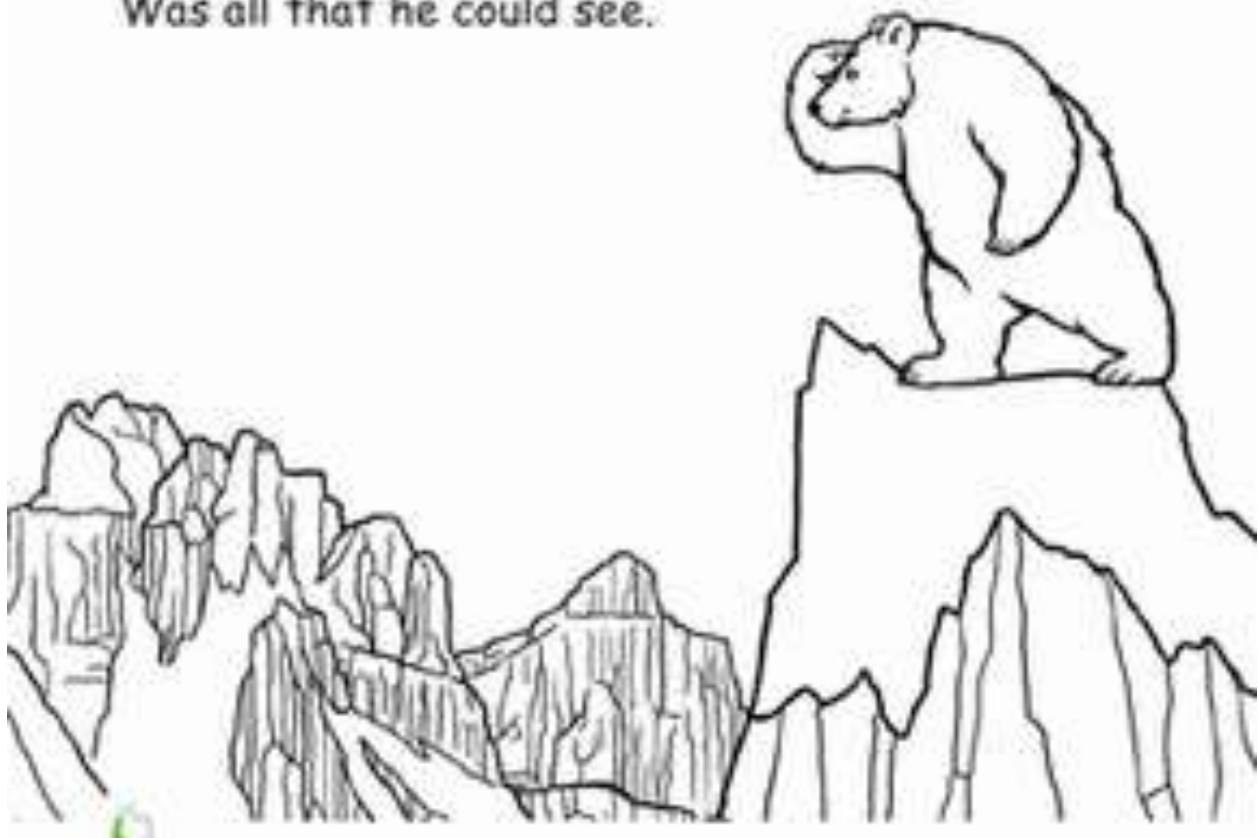
