



#### In Maths we will be:

We will be:

- · Sorting, matching, and comparing objects like bears and socks by size and shape.
- Exploring capacity through hands-on activities like Which Holds More? and Water Pour Challenge.
- Using words like full, empty, more, less, and holds more.
- · Taking turns, making predictions, and talking about what we notice.

#### In Phonics we will be:

We will be:

- Listening for environmental sounds and describing what we hear.
- Practising oral blending with games like Jump the Sounds and Cross the River.
- Using robot talk (e.g. "c-a-t" for cat) to help children hear and blend sounds.
- Singing familiar songs in different voices to keep sound play fun and engaging.

## Learning opportunities:

We will be:

- Using remote control cats to explore movement and practise turn-taking.
- Creating our own "I Spy" books to support drawing and early writing.
- Exploring feelings through The Ugly Duckling using mirrors and story play.
- Painting together with toy cars and rollers to make marks and work as a team.
