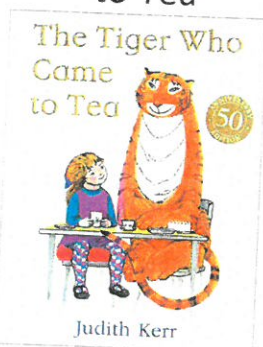

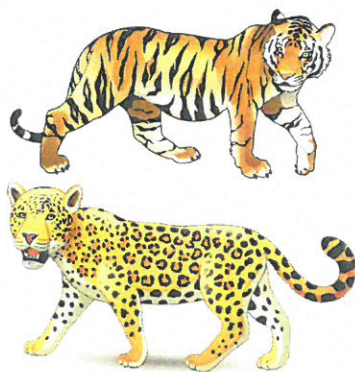
### Book of the week:

thank you



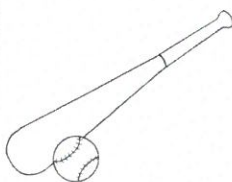
### Sounds of the week:

Pretend to hit a ball with a bat, saying, b, b, b.

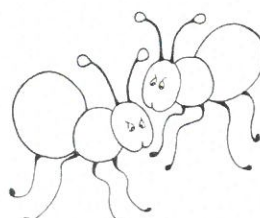

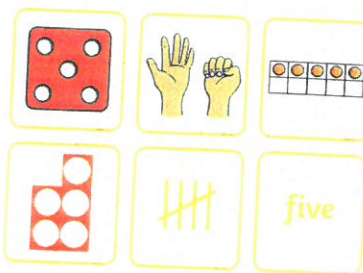
#### ACTION
