B-I-N-G-O

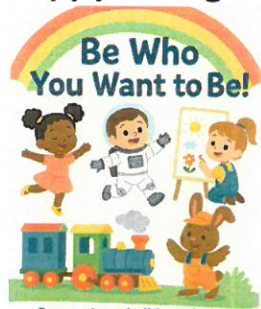

**Happy Thought:**

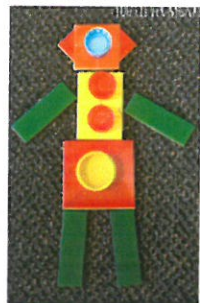


Dance, draw, build, or sing -

- Using 2d shapes to create some of the things we know e.g. a house, rocket, robot or train.



**In Phonics we will be:**

We will be:

- Playing a 'Copycat' repeated rhythm games.
- Matching different objects to sounds by focusing on their initial sounds.
- Playing lots of turn taking and speaking and listening games



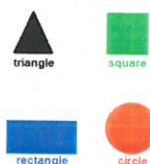
**Learning opportunities:**
