

This week in Willow

Outdoors:

Outside the children will continue to develop play on a large scale with sand, water, small world, loose parts, construction and the mud kitchen. Resources are available to develop physical skills and imaginative play. The children will be supported with routines such as putting on coats, waterproof trousers and wellies.

This week's outdoor learning provocations include:

- building with large loose parts
- sensory play with oats
- rolling balls into the water
- · potion making in the mud kitchen



Indoors:

We will be continuing to teach routines and support the children to choose, use and return resources in the areas of provision.

We will start introducing 'Learning Provocations'. These are activities that the children can choose to do in the areas of provision. They are open ended activities to support the children to develop skills.

This week's indoor learning provocations include:

- washing dolls in the water area
- · using scissors in the dough
- painting and drawing opportunities
- imaginative play with sea creatures
- · different size worms in the sand
